

NOTICE

On February 27, 2008, the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Ohio notified the district's ECF attorneys and trustees that due to limitations in the ECF application, Form 177, Notice of Assets, did not properly display the Proof of Claim Bar Date on Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) forms. As a result, the Court decided to no longer generate Form 177 in EDI format for Chapter 7 cases. Since that time, EDI noticing partners have received the Notice of Assets in an alternate form.

Due to recent improvements in the ECF application, Form 177 will now properly display the Proof of Claim Bar Date on EDI forms. Therefore, effective **November 1, 2010**, the Court will recommence generation of Form 177 in EDI format for Chapter 7 cases. The Court will implement this change by modifying the CM/ECF docket event *Notice of Assets & Request for Notice to Creditors*, used only by Chapter 7 trustees, effective the same date.

After the event is modified, the ECF prompt for a "Proof of Claims Deadline" will be auto-calculated and auto-completed, where formerly it was blank. The bar date will be calculated as the filed date plus 100 days, adjusted to avoid any date the Court is closed. This date will be displayed in the clerk's notice to creditors.
